Thank you very much for your invitation to present the prestigious Captain Walton Drake Cup to the winning team. This reception is a wonderful social occasion that recognises the rich and long history of the relationship between the Royal Australian Navy and the Royal Hobart Golf Club.

The history of your Walton Drake Cup goes back to then District Naval Officer in Tasmania, Captain Walton Drake, who instigated the competition between the Navy and the Royal Hobart Golf Club in the early 1900s.

Since then, I am told, Navy has never beaten our local Royal Hobart team in the competition.

This year's Competition was very close. I am pleased to announce that Royal Hobart Golf Club have retained their unbeaten status. I now have great pleasure in presenting the Cup to the winning team Captain.
