Good afternoon, everyone and welcome to another year of this significant annual event hosted by Cancer Council Tasmania.

The impact of cancer on our families cannot be overstated. Tomorrow, we make a pledge to fight back and do something that will make a difference in our fight against the disease.²

Our Cancer Council provides high quality support services for people with cancer, their families, carers and friends and also invests in cancer prevention programs and educates our community about lifestyle factors that can decrease cancer risk. Our Council also provides a respected voice for the needs of people affected by cancer.
