REMARKS BY
HER EXCELLENCY THE HONOURABLE BARBARA BAKER AC
GOVERNOR OF TASMANIA
OATLANDS, SATURDAY 9 AUGUST 2025**

Good afternoon, everyone. I am delighted to be here in Oatlands to celebrate the launch of Open House Southern Midlands, here at one of the oldest Supreme Court Houses in Australia.

May I begin by acknowledging the palawa people, the traditional owners of the land upon which we gather. I acknowledge today's Tasmanian Aboriginal Community as ongoing custodians of Country. I recognise their enduring culture and deep connection to land, sea, sky, and waters.

I previously visited here during my official visit to the Southern Midlands municipality, when we were guided on a heritage walking tour of Oatlands. May I acknowledge Mayor Edwin Batt and Deputy Mayor Karen Dudgeon whom we met during our official visit and who are with us today.

Our Southern Midlands is rich with Tasmania's built history. As you travel through this area's villages and rural districts, you can find many examples of 19th century architecture, including convict-built grand Georgian homesteads as well as small workers' cottages.¹

Many historic buildings can now be highlighted through the Open House programme.

This celebration of architecture, design and our State's built history has been encouraging Tasmanians to be tourists in our own towns since 2013.
